Finalist Notes:

Contestants must wear back numbers at all times, if you don't have your back number volunteers will ask you to pay.

All family members with you must pay to get in and have a wristband, no wristband and the volunteers will not allow you in the arena. If they lose a wristband there will be no replacements, you will need to purchase another one. Cash only or Preurchased Tickets will be accepted at the side door (east side of bldg). Debit, Credit, Cash will be accepted at the main door (west side of bldg), you will need to come around the outside to pay there, you can't come through the arena.

Must be in Western Attire minimum 1 hour before performance starts, will be required to be in Western Attire for Group Photos

TIME LIMIT FOR ALL EVENTS

A one minute time limit will be in effect from when the barrier is strung or the contestants is "waived in" in the barrel racing, under judges stop watch & Discretion.

Barrel Racing: At one minute contestant must mount a different horse or be flagged out

Cattle Timed Events: If animal is in standing position, a 30 second warning will be called. At one minute contestant or hazer must mount a different horse or be flagged out.

Roughstock Contestants: When the chute boss/judge advises you that you are next you must be above the animal with your glove on (if glove is used) when previous animal leaves the arena

1st Offence: \$50 Fine; 2nd Offence: \$100; Fine 3rd Offence: \$150 Fine

Each Additional Offence \$200 Fine
